

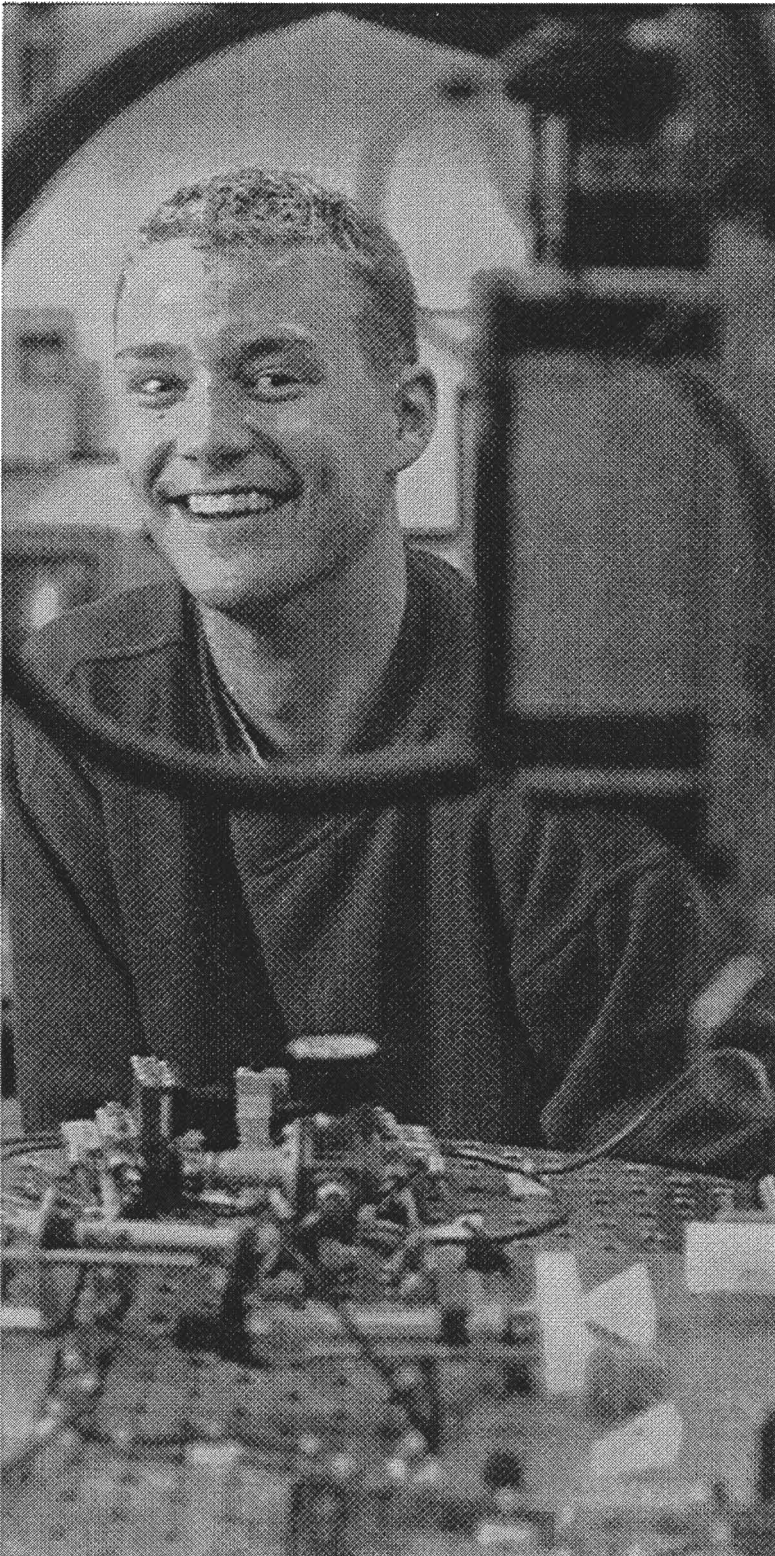

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Notes on Statistical Tables 2001-02

1. Up to and including 1993-94, UGC/UFC definitions have been used in cumulative tables and the figures were calculated at the UGC/UFC baseline of 31 December. From 1994-95 HEFCE/HESA definitions have been used and the baseline has been changed to 1 December to coincide with the HESES and initial HESA returns. This will make comparisons with previous years unreliable and care should be taken when producing comparative figures.
2. Overseas students are those who are overseas for the purpose of fees according to the definition on p 165 *Statutes and Ordinances 2001*.
3. Fee Codes (Tables 00/UG/03A, 00/UG/04A, 00/PG/03A and 00/PG/05A) are as defined in p. 161 *Statutes and Ordinances 2001*.
4. Ethnicity and Disability data is that provided by the students themselves on admission and is not updated thereafter.
5. **Undergraduate numbers.** All undergraduates in residence and Modern Linguists, Oriental Studies and Law students on a compulsory year abroad were counted. Distribution between subjects differs from load distribution as follows: third year pre-clinical medical and veterinary students were included under the headings 'Medicine' or 'Veterinary Medicine' irrespective of the Tripos examination for which they were entered. All other students were included under the heading most appropriate to the broad subject of the examination entry. 7th term clinical medical students are included in the numbers although they are counted as a load of 0.33.
6. **Undergraduate Student Load.** All undergraduates in residence were counted. The calculating of student load differs from the method used in counting numbers in the following respects:
 - (i) Third year medical and veterinary students entered for examination other than medicine were counted as a load on the Faculty/Department appropriate to the Tripos examination for which they were entered.
 - (ii) Modern Linguists and Oriental Studies students spending a compulsory year abroad were counted as a load of 0.5 on the appropriate Faculty or Department although they were included in the numbers as full-time students. Students away on other fully reciprocal exchanges, e.g. Erasmus/Socrates, were counted as a load of zero.
 - (iii) Candidates for Triposes such as English or History were counted as a load of 1.0 on the Faculty/Department concerned. Other candidates were counted as fractional load on Departments appropriate to the papers they were offering. Thus a candidate for Part IA of the Natural Sciences Tripos offering Chemistry, Physics, Materials and Mineral Sciences, and Mathematics was counted as a load of 0.27 on Chemistry, 0.27 on Physics, 0.14 on Earth Sciences, 0.13 on Materials Science and Metallurgy, 0.16 on DAMTP, and 0.03 on the Computer Laboratory.

- (iv) The detailed calculation of undergraduate load is fairly complex and is based on instructions approved by the General Board. Any queries should be directed to Head of Student Records and Statistics, at the address below, in the first instance.

7. **Postgraduate Load.** All postgraduates included in the 1 December HESA return were included with the exception of those who were approved for degrees or other qualifications or had withdrawn from the Register of Graduate Students before 1 December.

The students were counted according to the Department in which they were working on the postgraduate course/research. These Departments were then assigned to a Cost Centre (see Appendix). Full-time students were counted as a load of 1.0 with the exception of M.B.A. students who were counted as a load of 1.0 for each term that they were in residence and 0.2 for each term out of residence. In practise this means that the load for students on the three-year course is 0.47 each year; for those on the two-year course 0.47 in the first year and 0.73 in the second year, and 1.0 for those on the one-year course. Students coded as other than full-time and given a HEFCE Mode of 31 (according to the definition contained in Appendix Definition C) were counted as 0.5, or if the Mode is 43, 63, or 64 as zero.

8. **Postgraduate Courses.** Taken from registered qualification. If Graduate Students were not yet registered for a qualification they are shown as such. (In previous years they have been shown as Ph.D.).
9. **Distribution of Student Load between Faculties and Departments.** This distribution, derived from undergraduate and postgraduate load tables, is designed to reflect FTE student load as accurately as possible, and is made according to rules determined by the General Board. 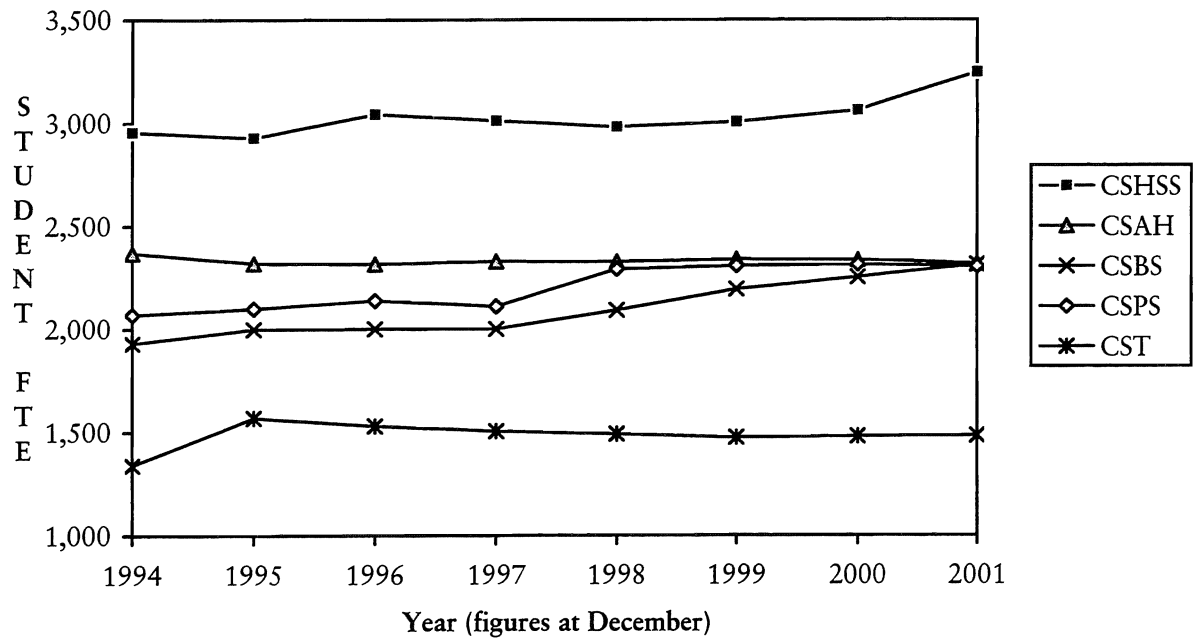

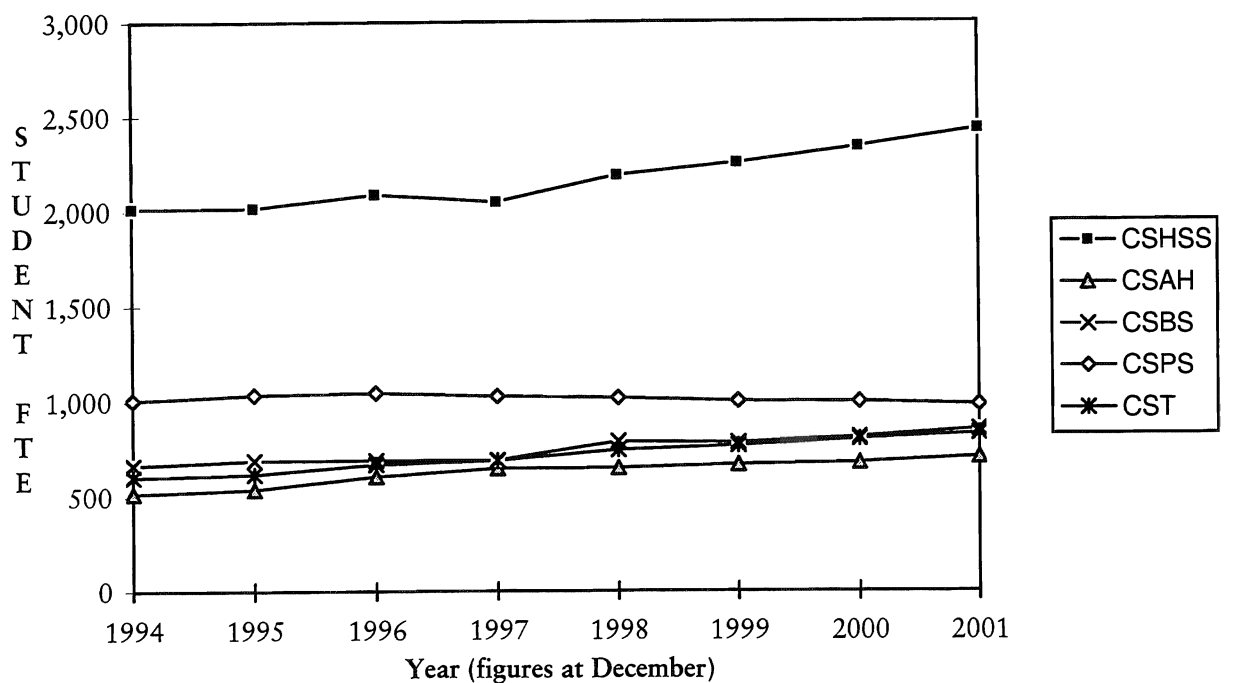

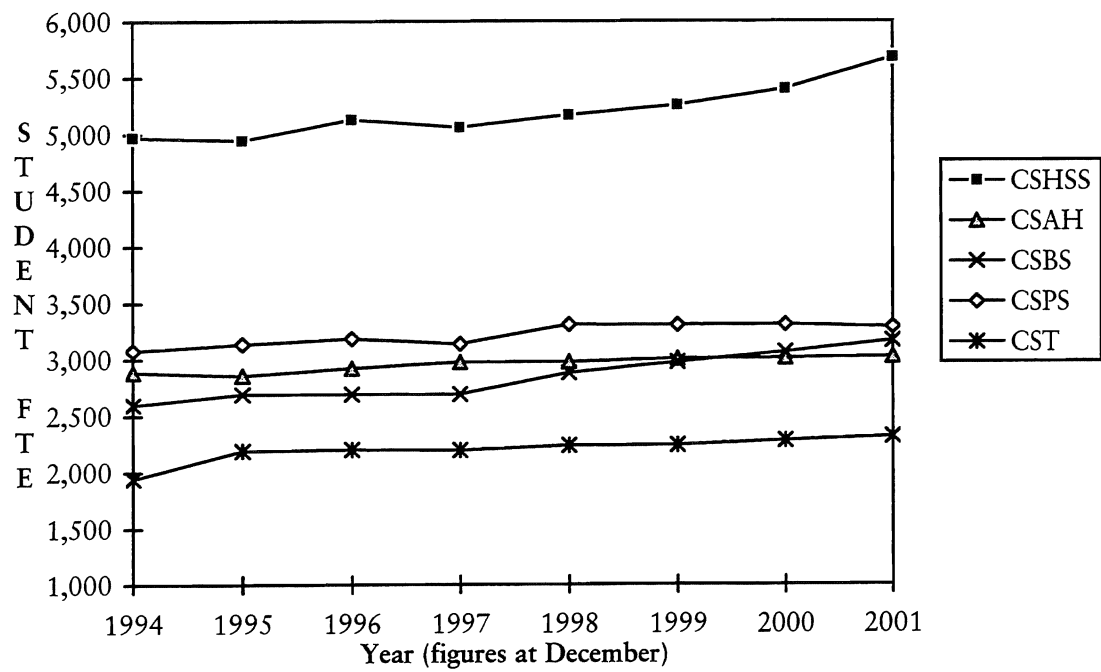
FTE Student Load by Schools: Undergraduates
