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UNIVERSITY STATISTICS 1980-81

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1. UGC definitions (attached as appendices) have been used throughout unless otherwise stated.
2. Overseas students are those who are overseas for the purpose of fees according to the 1967 UGC definition and includes EEC students paying the home rate of University Fees.
3. Undergraduate numbers: Table 80/AS/10 All undergraduates in residence were counted. Distribution between subject differs from load distribution as follows: third year medical and veterinary students were included under the headings 'Medicine' or 'Veterinary Medicine' irrespective of the Tripos examination for which they were entered; candidates for the Qualifying Examination in Education were included under the heading 'Education' (although the majority take papers from other Tripos examinations). All other students were included under the heading most appropriate to the broad subject of their examination entry.
4. Undergraduate Student Load: Tables 80/AS/12 and 13 All undergraduates in residence were counted. The calculating of student load differs from the method used for counting student numbers in the following respects:
 - (i) Third year medical and veterinary students entered for examinations other than medicine were counted as a load on the Faculty/Department appropriate to the Tripos examination for which they were entered.
 - (ii) Candidates for the Qualifying Examination in Education were counted as a load of 0.33 on the Department of Education and 0.67 on the Department(s) appropriate to the Tripos papers the candidate was offering or the special papers (not from a Tripos) which certain candidates were offering.
 - (iii) Candidates for Triposes such as English or History were counted as a load of '1' on the Faculty/Department concerned.
 - (iv) Other candidates were counted as fractional load on Departments appropriate to the papers they were offering. Thus, a candidate for Part IA of the Natural Sciences Tripos offering Chemistry, Crystalline Materials, Physics and Mathematics was counted as a load of 0.25 on Chemistry, 0.25 on Physics, 0.25 on Mathematics, 0.125 on Mineralogy and Petrology, 0.125 on Metallurgy and Materials Science; i.e. a load of 0.625 on UGC Group 12 (Physical Sciences). 0.125 on UGC Group 06 (Engineering) and 0.25 on UGC Group 11 (mathematics) - results being given to one place of decimals.
 - (v) To show teaching load on Departments as accurately as possible - the load of Crystalline Materials is distributed equally between Mineralogy and Petrology and Metallurgy and Materials Science, i.e. Group 12 (Physical Sciences) and Group 06 (Engineering); the load of Biology of Cells is distributed equally among Botany, Genetics, Zoology and Biochemistry, i.e. 0.75 to Biological Sciences and 0.25 to Preclinical Medicine. Elementary Mathematics for Biologists and Biological Mathematics are distributed equally between Mathematics (Group 11) and Applied Biology (Group 10: Biological Sciences); Comparative Pathology is distributed equally between Pathology (Group 02: Preclinical Medicine) and Clinical Veterinary Medicine (Group 09). Other distributions between two or more Departments do not involve division between UGC Groups.
5. Postgraduate Student Load: Tables 80/AS/23 and 24 All postgraduates returnable to the Universities Statistical Record as part of the annual postgraduate return based at 31 December were included with the exception of those who, before 31 December, were approved for degrees or other qualifications or had withdrawn from the Register of Graduate Students.

The Students were counted according to the Departments in which they were working on their postgraduate course. These Departments were then assigned to a UGC Group (see Appendix). Graduate Students working in non-University Institutions were all coded as not full-time. Full-time students were counted as a load of '1'. Students coded as other than full-time and given an appropriate code (according to the definition attached as Appendix) were counted as '0.5'.

6. Differences between Provisional and Final Figures

- (i) Students expected to matriculate who did not do so.
- (ii) Students expected to return for a postgraduate course who did not do so.
- (iii) Graduate Students approved for degrees or withdrawn from the Register during the second half of the Michaelmas Term.
- (iv) Graduate Students who submitted dissertation during the Michaelmas Term moved from full-time to not full-time figures.

7. Postgraduate Courses: Tables 80/AS/17-21 and 25 Taken from registered qualification. If students were not yet registered for a qualification, Ph.D was assumed (by agreement with the Board of Graduate Studies).

8. Distribution of Student Load among Faculties and Departments: Table 80/AS/30 This distribution, derived from undergraduate and postgraduate load tables, is designed to show teaching load as accurately as possible, and is made according to rules determined by the General Board.

The sole exception to this rule is the Equine Research Station whose students are allocated to UGC Group (09) - Veterinary Sciences regardless of their Degree Committee.

POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS - FULL/NOT FULL-TIME DEFINITION

The records of all Postgraduate students on the computer (Main File) will be classified FULL-TIME (Code 10) for the purposes of UGC and USR returns with the following exceptions:

Students who are actively engaged on courses of research or other postgraduate work IN RESIDENCE during the Michaelmas Term in which the count is taken should be coded:

- 21 if holding an established University post
- 22 if research assistants financed from Research Council Grants or Research contracts
- 23 if in 4th or subsequent year of their current course of study

Students who are actively engaged on courses of research or other postgraduate work, with formal leave to work OUT OF RESIDENCE during the Michaelmas Term in which the count is taken should be coded:

- 41 if holding an established University post
- 42 if research assistants financed from Research Council Grants or Research contracts
- 43 if working in a non-University institution**
- 44 if in 1st, 2nd or 3rd year of their current course of study
- 45 if in 4th or subsequent year of their current course of study

Students who are no longer actively engaged on courses of research or other postgraduate work during the Michaelmas Term in which the count is taken should be coded:

- 51 if intermitting their course of study during the Michaelmas Term in which the count is taken
- 52 if submitted/re-submitted dissertation before the end of the Michaelmas Term in which the count is taken

** Note: All Graduate Students working in non-University institutions are for this purpose considered to be OUT OF RESIDENCE

The following students are excluded from the count:

- A student whose date of admission to research (or other postgraduate) course is later than 31 December of the year to which the count relates.
- A student who has been approved for the qualification for which he is registered (or who has withdrawn) before 31 December of the year to which the count relates.
- Students returned to USR on the IDU/1 and IDU/2 returns, (ie Undergraduates).
