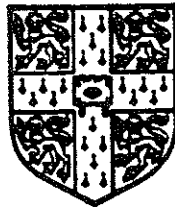

Notes on Statistical Tables 1988-89

1. UGC definitions (attached as appendices) have been used throughout unless otherwise stated. The UGC baseline of 31 December 1988 has been used for throughout these tables.
2. Overseas students are those who are overseas for the purpose of fees according to the definition on p.198 Ordinances 1988.
3. Undergraduate numbers. All undergraduates in residence and Modern Linguists on a compulsory year abroad were counted. Distribution between subject differs from load distribution as follows: Third year pre-clinical medical and veterinary students were included under the headings 'Medicine' or 'Veterinary Medicine' irrespective of the Tripos examination for which they were entered; candidates for the Qualifying Examination in Education were included under the heading 'Education' (although the majority take papers from other Tripos examinations). All other students were included under the heading most appropriate to the broad subject of the examination entry. 7th term clinical medical students are not included in the numbers although they are counted as a load of one-third.
4. Undergraduate Student Load. All undergraduates in residence were counted. The calculating of student load differs from the method used for counting student numbers in the following respects:
 - (i) Third year medical and veterinary students entered for examinations other than medicine were counted as a load on the Faculty/Department appropriate to the Tripos examination for which they were entered.
 - (ii) Candidates for the Qualifying Examination in Education were counted as a load of 0.5 on the Department of Education and 0.5 on the Department(s) appropriate to the Tripos papers the candidate was offering or the special papers (not from a Tripos) which certain candidates were offering.
 - (iii) Modern Linguists spending a compulsory year abroad were counted as a load of 0.5 on the Faculty of Modern and Medieval Languages although included in the numbers of full-time students.
 - (iv) Candidates for Triposes such as English or History were counted as a load of '1' on the Faculty/Department concerned.
 - (v) Other candidates were counted as fractional load on Departments appropriate to the papers they were offering. Thus a candidate for Part IA of the Natural Sciences Tripos offering Chemistry, Physics, Crystalline Materials, and Mathematics was counted as a load of 0.28 on Chemistry, 0.28 on Physics, 0.14 on Earth Sciences, 0.14 on Metallurgy and Materials Science and 0.16 on Mathematics.
 - (vi) The detailed calculation of undergraduate load is fairly complex and is based on instructions approved by the General Board. Any queries should be directed to Mr. D. Barrington-Light, University Registry in the first instance.

5. Postgraduate Student Load. All postgraduates returnable to the Universities Statistical Record as part of the annual postgraduate return based at 31 December were included with the exception of those who, before 31 December, were approved for degrees or other qualifications or had withdrawn from the Register of Graduate Students.

The students were counted according to the Departments in which they were working on the postgraduate course. These Departments were then assigned to a UGC Academic Department Group Cost Centre (see Appendix). Graduate Students working in non-University institutions were all coded as not full-time. Full-time students were counted as a load of '1' with the exception of candidates for the Postgraduate Certificate in Design, Manufacture and Management who were counted as '0.75'. Students coded as other than full-time and given as appropriate code (according to the definition attached as Appendix) were counted as '0.5' if coded in the range 21-45, and zero if coded 51 or 52.

6. Postgraduate Courses. Taken from registered qualification. If students were not yet registered for a qualification, Ph.D. was assumed (by agreement with the Board of Graduate Studies).
7. Distribution of Student Load amongst Faculties and Departments: Table 88/DL/01. This distribution, derived from undergraduate and postgraduate load tables, is designed to reflect FTE student load as accurately as possible, and is made according to rules determined by the General Board. Any queries should be addressed to Mr. Barrington-Light in the first instance.

POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS - FULL/NOT FULL-TIME DEFINITION

The records of all postgraduate students will be classified FULL-TIME (Code 10) for the purposes of UGC and USR returns with the following exceptions (the status of students is taken as at 31 December of the year in which the count relates):

- 21 Graduate Students holding established University posts.
- 22 Graduate Students who are research assistants financed from Research Council grants or research contracts.
- 23 Graduate Students in 4th or subsequent year of their course of study and in residence.
- 24 Graduate Students in 1st, 2nd, or 3rd year of their current course of study and not in residence.
- 25 Graduate Students in 1st, 2nd, or 3rd year of their current course of study, working in non-University institutions.
- 43 Graduate Students in 4th or subsequent year of their current course of study and not in residence.
- 45 Graduate Students in 4th or subsequent year of their current course of study, working in non-University institutions.
- 51 Graduate Students intermitting their course of study.
- 52 Graduate Students who are under examination (eg they have submitted/re-submitted their dissertation).

The following students are excluded from the status of Full/Not Full-time:

A Graduate Student whose date of admission to the Register of Graduate Students is later than 31 December of the year to which the count relates.

A student who has been approved for the qualification for which he is registered (or has been withdrawn) before 31 December of the year to which the count relates.

Students coded in the range 21-45 are included in statistics published by the UGC/USR as 'Part-time' students. Those coded in the range 51-52 are excluded from published statistics.
